FOREST ORDER NO. 14-20-02 MOUNT SHASTA WILDERNESS AREA CLOSURE SHASTA-TRINITY NATIONAL FOREST

Pursuant to 16 USC 551 and 36 CFR 261.53 (e), and to provide for public health and safety, the following act is prohibited on National Forest System lands under my jurisdiction within the Shasta-Trinity National Forest. This Order is effective from April 23, 2020, through April 30, 2020.

Entering or using any area within the Mount Shasta Wilderness above 10,000 feet in elevation, as shown in the attached map. 36 CFR 261.53(e).

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this Order:

- 1. Persons with a permit from the Forest Service specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act.
- 2. Any Federal, State, or local officer or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.

This prohibition is in addition to the general prohibitions found in 36 CFR Part 261, Subpart A, and all other orders issued pursuant to 36 CFR Part 261 Subpart B.

A violation of this prohibition is punishable by a fine of not more than \$5,000 for an individual or \$10,000 for an organization, or imprisonment for not more than six months, or both. 16 USC 551 and 18 USC 3559, 3571, and 3581.
